TAKE CARE OF TEXAS AWARD SCOUTS



BOY SCOUTS PATCH

The Take Care of Texas Award recognizes Scouts who are doing their part to conserve water and energy, keep our air and water clean, and reduce waste. The Award shows a commitment to both learning and educating others on how we can keep our state great.



Patch Requirements for Boy Scouts:

- Merit Badges: Earn three merit badges from the following list: Environmental Science, Soil and Water Conservation, Energy, Fish and Wildlife Management, Forestry, Sustainability, Gardening, Oceanography and Plant Science.
- Community Service Hours: In addition to the merit badges, Scout is required to complete 2 hours toward a conservation project.
- Hours resulting in resource improvement related to Eagle projects, Hornaday projects or other conservation related project for advancement can be applied toward award.
- Patches may be obtained from Becky Navarro in Support Services when you turn in completed forms
 documenting completion of the requirements. One form must be completed for each Scout applying.



Patches may be obtained at Support Services at the Cockrell Scout Service Center upon submission of completed application form.

Pin Requirements for Boy Scouts:

Complete Patch Requirements

- Conservation project: Scout must complete a project in line with the Take Care of Texas mission that includes at least 8 hours of service.
 - Presentation: Scout must submit to TCEQ either a 7-10 photo/slides presentation or a 3-5 minute video describing the project, how it relates to TCOT mission, and knowledge gained from experience.
 - Send completed form to <u>educate@tceq.texas.gov</u>.



Pin Requirements for Venturers and Adults:

- Conservation project: Scouter, Venturing Scout or Exploring Scout must lead a project in line with the Take Care of Texas mission that includes at least 8 hours of service. Scouter or Scout must briefly describe his or her work and have another leader on site verify your work.
- 2. Submit completed form to educate@tceq.texas.gov.

Examples of Conservation Projects:

Make a simple rain collection system Perform air, water, or soil quality tests Learn and collect native seeds for replanting Develop a reusing/recycling program that involves entire class or troop Develop Develop and promote energy conservation methods for your class or troop Organize an anti litter campaign and clean up. Plant trees for erosion control and/or air quality or energy conservation. Restore wetlands for runoff filtration to improve water quality
